NURSING ENTRANCE TEST INFORMATION**

All applicants must take the NET. The test fee is included in your \$100.00 application fee. An applicant will be assigned a test date when the application is received. You will need to bring a pen (blue or black ink), two sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers and a photo ID (i.e., driver's license, student ID, permanent resident card). Calculators are not permitted.

ONLY ASSIGNED APPLICANTS MAY SIT FOR THE EXAM.

The NET evaluates eight areas that are essential for academic success in nursing including basic math skills (with some algebra), science reading comprehension, writing and learning styles.

The NET may be retaken once. Please contact Norma Blas at nblas@solarishs.org, or 908-668-2450, to schedule an additional testing date.

INTERPRETING YOUR NET SCORES:

- A GENERIC OR LPN TRANSITION APPLICANT MUST EARN
56 OR HIGHER IN READING COMPREHENSION
65 OR HIGHER IN MATH
60 OR HIGHER AS A COMPOSITE SCORE

- AN ACCELERATED ELIGIBLE APPLICANT MUST EARN
65 OR HIGHER IN READING COMPREHENSION
65 OR HIGHER IN MATH
65 OR HIGHER AS A COMPOSITE SCORE

Applicants, who are not satisfied with their NET scores, may retake the exam once.
